

The Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC) and the Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSI) have requested that companies under take reasonable due diligence with their supply chains to assure that specified metals (Gold, Tin, Tantalum and Tungsten) are not being sourced from mines in the designated Conflict Region which includes the Democratic Republic of Congo and adjoining regions, as defined by the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer protection Act, Section 1502.

Transphorm supports the actions of the EICC and GeSI and has obtained or is in the process of obtaining information from our metal suppliers and subcontractors concerning the origin of the metals used in all of Transphorm's products. Suppliers must provide written evidence of due diligence documenting that all metals are being sourced from smelters that have been validated conflict free by an independent private sector firm. Having conducted a Reasonable Country of Origin Inquiry, Transphorm does not knowingly use metals from the Conflict Region in its products.
